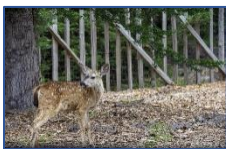
To be eligible applicants must have been a resident of Grass Valley for the previous 12 months, and a registered and verified voter for the City of Grass Valley.
