City of Grass Valley Ordinance 400, Section 37. Animals at



Large: B. No dog shall be permitted to run or be upon the public streets of the City, whether licensed or not, unless securely muzzled or led by a leash or chain by the owner or keeper thereof.

Definition of dog at large: A dog that is off the premises of the dog owner, not under control and the owner is not observed to be within sight of his/her dog.
