



ACCEPTANCE OF ORDINANCE NO. 2003-7

PACIFICORP, an Oregon corporation, doing business as **Pacific Power & Light Company**, hereby unconditionally accepts Ordinance No. 2003-7 of the City of Grass Valley, Sherman County, Oregon, and all the terms, provisions and conditions thereof, said ordinance being entitled:

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO PACIFICORP, AN OREGON CORPORATION, DOING BUSINESS AS PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, AND TO ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, A NONEXCLUSIVE RIGHT AND FRANCHISE FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY (20) YEARS TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE, IN, ON, AND UNDER THE PRESENT AND FUTURE STREETS, ALLEYS, BRIDGES AND PUBLIC PLACES OF THE CITY OF GRASS VALLEY, SHERMAN COUNTY, OREGON, ELECTRIC LIGHT AND POWER LINES AND APPURTENANCES, AND COMMUNICATION FACILITIES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPLYING ELECTRICITY AND ELECTRIC SERVICE TO THE CITY OF GRASS VALLEY, THE INHABITANTS THEREOF AND OTHERS, SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND TO THE MAKING OF PAYMENTS SPECIFIED IN THE ORDINANCE, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 127 OF THE CITY OF GRASS VALLEY, PASSED AND APPROVED November 7th, 1983.

which said ordinance was duly submitted at a regular meeting of the Council of the City of Grass Valley and read for the first time on the 8th day of September, 2003, was read in full the second time on the 6th day of October, 2003, and on the 3rd day of November, 2003 was duly signed by the Mayor and attested by the Recorder.
