- Wet garbage • Plastic • Asbestos • Wire insulation • Automobile parts • Asphalt • Petroleum treated materials • Painted wood and wood treated with creosote or pentachlorophenol • Rubber products including tires • Animal remains • Animal or vegetable matter resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking or service of food • Any other material that emits dense smoke or noxious odors
