


COMMUNITY WASTEWATER INFORMATIVE MEETING WITH CURRAN-MCLEOD

County-wide Cleanup May 1st

On May 1st, Sherman County residents are invited to bring one pick-up load of trash to the Solid Waste Transfer Station without paying a fee with some exceptions.

When: Saturday, May 1, 2021 – 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. **NOTE: Station may close early if bin is full before 3 p.m.**

Where: Sherman County Solid Waste Transfer Site located at 72526 Welk Road between Highway 206 and Biggs Junction.

How: Upon arrival, wait for the attendant to direct you to the appropriate unloading site.

Limited: One trip per vehicle.

Restrictions:

- No household, hazardous, or medical waste will be accepted.
- No recycling.

Fees are required for:

Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners \$34.43 each
Appliances \$13.06
Tires without rims \$12.46
Tires with rims \$16.63
Furniture \$13.06

You may also bring:



BURNING

As a reminder to everyone as the Burn Ban has been lifted, there is ABSOLUTELY NO UNSUPERVISED BURNING! All fires must be attended until completely extinguished. You also must have suppression methods on-hand at all times of burning.

DEER POPULATION




