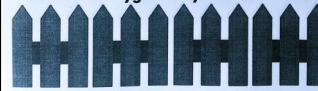

Citizens and community officials have the right to appeal new flood zone map but they must have concrete written evidence showing that evaluations provided are wrong. For example, a private survey done on the contested area. See websites for more information:
